# How to access

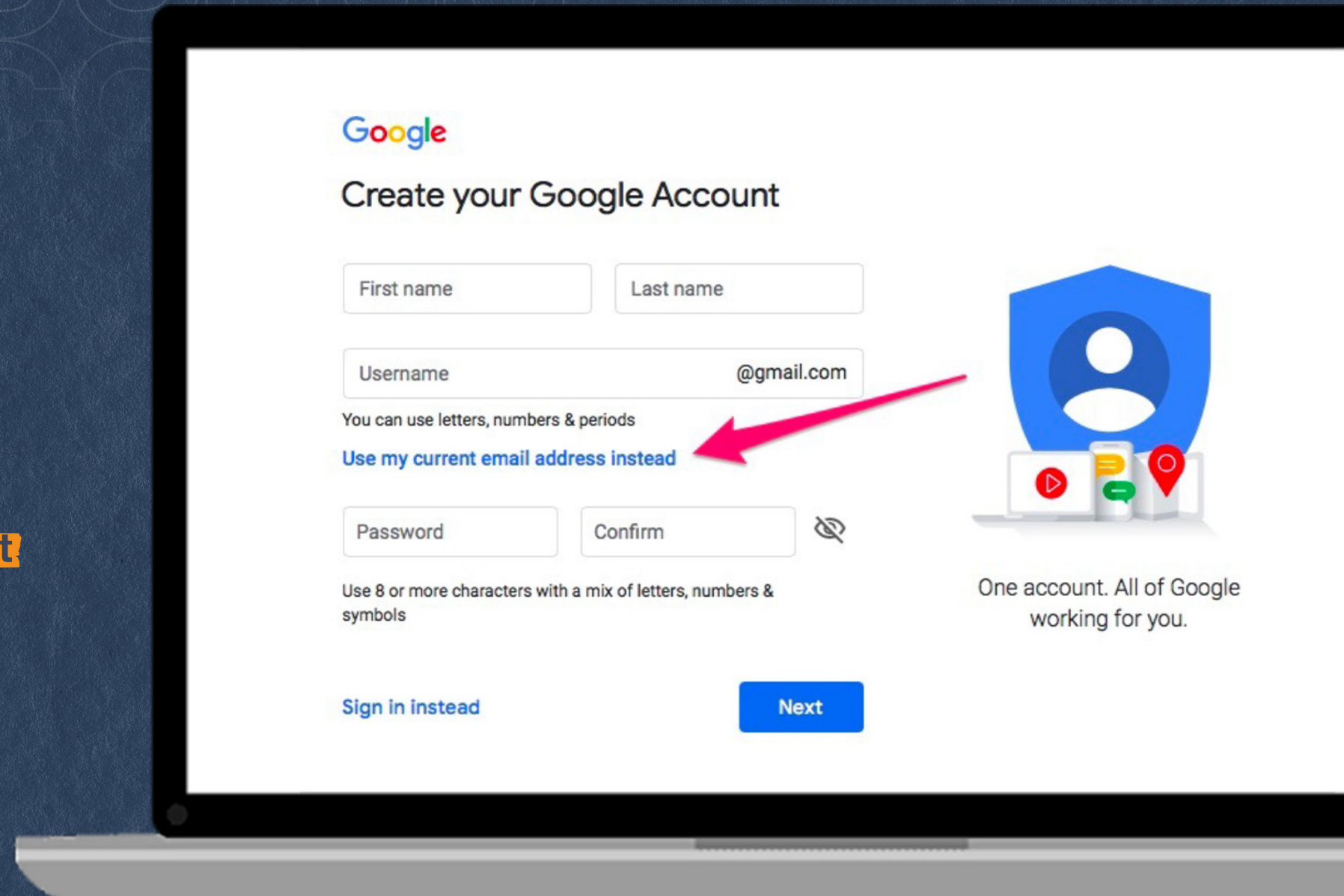
1. Go to [groups.google.com](https://groups.google.com) - Here you will see the groups you've signed for.

\*Note: To be able to see the groups you need to confirm a couple steps first:

- a. Are you logged in with the same gmail account that you have registered for the group?
- b. If you are using a corporate account you may need to associate you email account to Google:

1. Go to [google.com](https://google.com) - Select **Create an account** **at the top right corner**, or by visiting [here](#).

*\*Make sure you are logged out of all other Google/Gmail accounts first.*





# How to access

2. Fill out the Create your Google Account form. Then select **"Use my current email address instead"**. Use a new password for the Google-linked account.
3. Once complete, let your Account Manager know the email address you registered with Google.

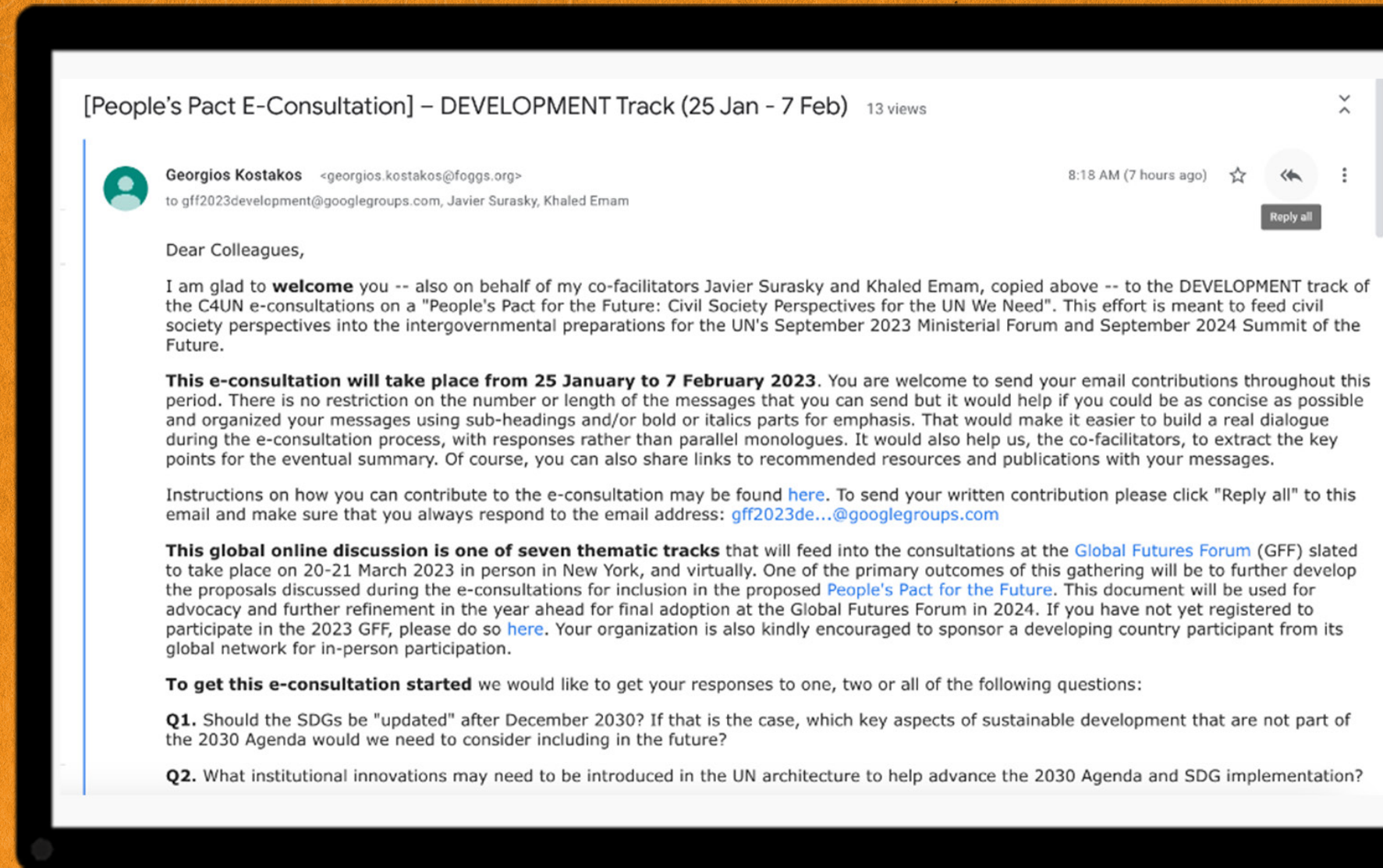

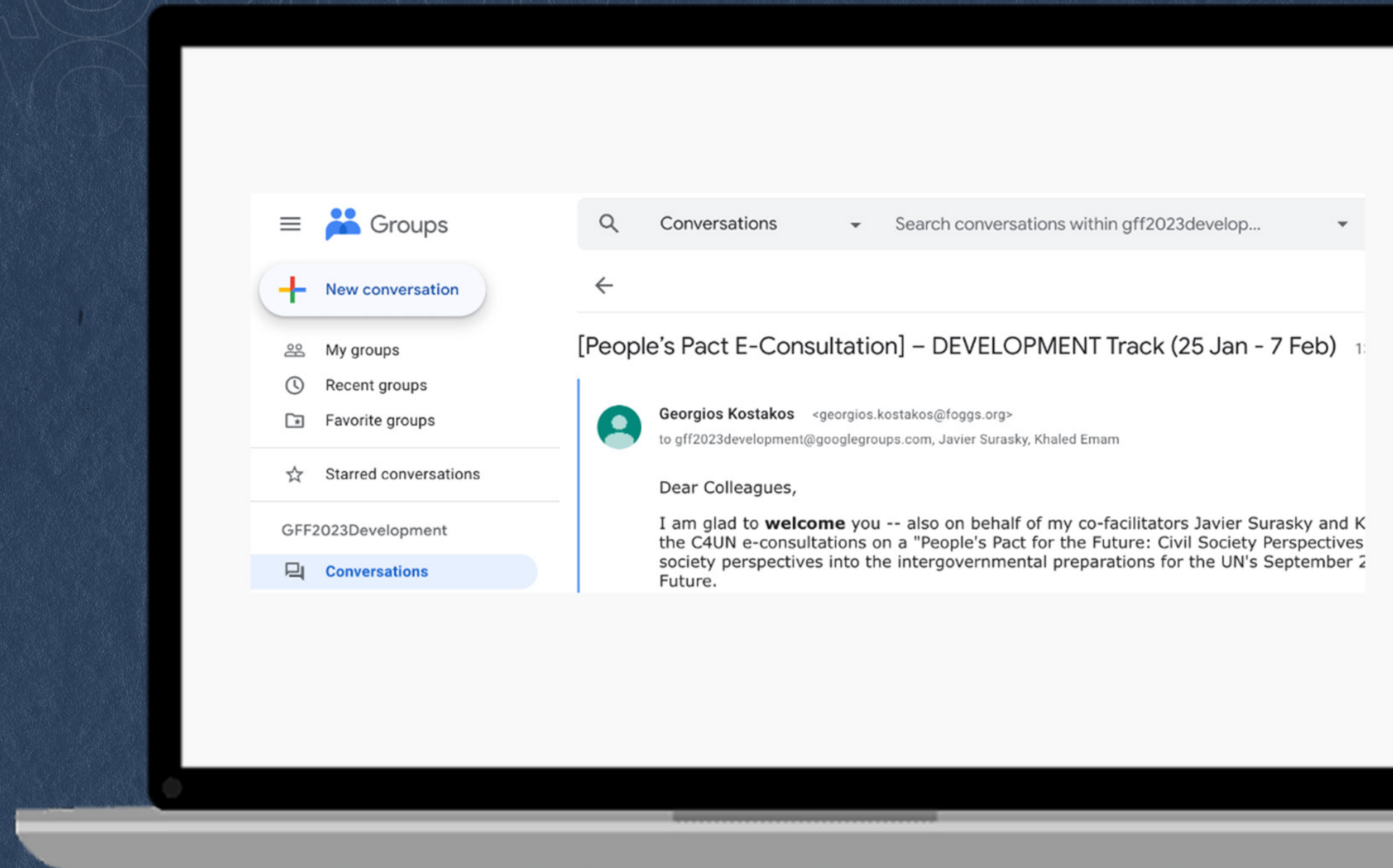
2. Each track will start on its scheduled date. The co-facilitators will send you a welcoming message to get the conversations started.
