People's Pact for the Future.




1. Go to (groups.google.com) - Here you will see the groups you've signed for.


*Note: To be able to see the groups you need to confirm a couple steps first:

- a. Are you logged in with the same gmail account that you have registered for the group?
- b. If you are using a corporate account you may need to associate you email account to Google:
- 1. Go to google.com Select Create an account at the top right corner, or by visiting here.

 *Make sure you are logged out of all other Google/Gmail accounts first.



- 2. Fill out the Create your Google Account form.
 Then select "Use my current email address instead". Use a new password for the Google-linked account.
- 3. Once complete, let your Account Manager know the email address you registered with Google.



This global online discussion is one of seven thematic tracks that will feed into the consultations at the Global Futures Forum (GFF) slated to take place on 20-21 March 2023 in person in New York, and virtually. One of the primary outcomes of this gathering will be to further develop the proposals discussed during the e-consultations for inclusion in the proposed People's Pact for the Future. This document will be used for advocacy and further refinement in the year ahead for final adoption at the Global Futures Forum in 2024. If you have not yet registered to participate in the 2023 GFF, please do so here. Your organization is also kindly encouraged to sponsor a developing country participant from its global network for in-person participation.

To get this e-consultation started we would like to get your responses to one, two or all of the following questions:
